HEADLICE

It has come to my attention that there has been a case of headlice in school.

I would like to advise all parents to check your child (ren's) hair on a regular basis, as there are a number of cases of headlice in the school.

Combing is an important part of good personal care therefore the best way to check for headlice and to get ride of them is through wet combing and using plenty of conditioner.

May I also suggest that girls have their hair tied up whilst in school, to help stop the spread of headlice whilst the children are working closely together.

If your child is found to have headlice parents will be contacted immediately to come and collect their child from school.

Children may return to school once they have been treated.
