Behaviour Policy Addendum (Covid-19)

The principles of our main school behaviour policy continue to stand.

Expectations

In addition to the expectations in the behaviour policy, during this time we are also including the following expectations, which are in line with the Covid-19 Home School Agreement which can also be found on our school website:

- where possible observe social distancing,
- follow the hygiene rules that are in place,
- stay in the allocated areas of school only,
- only interact in school with those in your group,
- will behave in a safe and respectful manner.

Positive Consequences

Due to Covid-19 it has been necessary for us to adapt the positive consequences which we will use to reward pupils' good and outstanding behaviour. These are:

- Verbal praise and encouragement
- Positive Dojos
- A virtual postcard home via Class Dojo
- A virtual certificate via Class Dojo
- Golden Time

Traffic Light System

The traffic light system will continue to be used to help support the children, who are having minor difficulties, to make the right choices with their behaviour.

Supportive Consequences

Due to Covid-19 it has been necessary for us to adapt the supportive consequences. If the children are having minor difficulties with making the right choices, the following supportive consequences will be implemented. The consequences follow in a step-by-step order:

1. Use of 'needs work' Dojos
2. 5 minutes off playtime or lunchtime
3. Socially distanced conversation with SLT
4. Parents contacted via a phone call

Significant Behaviour That May Cause Harm to Self or Others

Due to Covid-19, school considers the following behaviours to cause risk of harm to either oneself or other members of the school community:

- Leaving the classroom without permission
- Accessing out of bounds areas
- Physical altercations
- Deliberately coughing, sneezing, biting or spitting at or towards another person
- Persistently disruptive behaviour

For any pupil who displays these behaviours, parents will be contacted and asked to collect their child from school immediately. The pupil will be required to remain at home until further arrangements can be made. If necessary, your child may need to be isolated from the rest of their group until you arrive at school. Your child will be supervised by a member of staff, who may be required to wear PPE.

The wellbeing and safety of our pupils, staff and parents/carers is of the utmost importance at all times, but especially so during the COVID-19 pandemic. This is why the aforementioned behaviour cannot be tolerated in school.
